

Footpath Repairs at long last

The filthy state of the footpath between Lowndes Avenue and Wallington Road was raised at a recent meeting of Asheridge Vale and Lowndes Community Association.

Chairman Cllr Chris Spruytenburg and a resident wrote to the owners. Very promptly they replied saying that they would undertake to ensure that the footway would be maintained in a better state than at present. They also promised that when ownership passed to the developers of adjacent Maple Court, steps would be taken to ensure the path was maintained in a decent condition.

"I am very encouraged by this response and I hope this will be followed through by the developers of the new complex.

We are also hopeful that this attitude will be carried through to the construction period of the new elderly people's complex, and that neighbours in the nearby sheltered homes will suffer as little disruption as possible," said councillor Spruytenburg. "Your Liberal Democrat councillors will keep a close eye on the situation to ensure the developers are as good as their word," he said.

The path is well used by residents and parents taking their children to and from Elmtree School, so it is important that the path is kept clean and that dog owners don't allow their pets to foul the area.

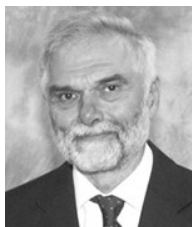
